Additional Request

In addition to the information requested in the two attachments we have one outstanding question that came up during our consolidation process for the *2023 GDS Index*.

In your OIA response for the *2023 GDS Index* (27/03/24), you noted that two of the GDSs listed had been transferred to Te Whatu Ora – Health New Zealand (Health NZ) and one was jointly held with Health NZ. However, Health NZ is not currently listed as a government department according to Schedule 2 of the Public Service Act 2020.

The related strategies are:

- 1. Palliative Care Strategy (February, 2001)
- 2. Planned Care Strategic Approach: 2019–2024 (September, 2019)
- 3. Te Mana Ola: The Pacific Health Strategy (July, 2023)

Question: Please could you confirm whether the above three strategies are now:

- i. solely held by MOH,
- ii. archived, or
- iii. transferred to another government department (please state the department and date transferred).
