Sustainable Future calls on New Zealanders to commit to a national strategy

Unlike many other countries. New Zealand does not have a suitable institutional framework to progress a national strategy, according to latest research from Sustainable Future.

The independent think-tank has just released its latest research reports as part of Project 2058, a two year research project aiming to promote long-term thinking and leadership in sustainable development. A short Think Piece was also prepared to accompany the reports, titled What is a National Sustainable Development Strategy?

The three reports, (i) Institutions for Sustainable Development: Learning from international experience. (ii) Institutions for Sustainable Development: Developing an optimal framework for New Zealand, and (iii) The Common Elements of a National Sustainable Development Strategy: Learning from international experience. investigate international best-practice, to understand how well-equipped New Zealand is to progress such a strategy.

Sustainable Future's Chief Executive, Wendy McGuinness, recommends that "government should establish a Sustainable Development Council, and designate an existing government body as the lead decision-making body to progress sustainable development."

Sustainable Future believes that because international examples showed a tendency towards a focus on external pressures and challenges, there is an opportunity for New Zealand to develop a strategy that stands out in terms of marketing our values and unique competitive advantages to the world.

And Mrs McGuinness says "Perhaps more importantly, a National Sustainable Development Strategy would provide a mechanism to encourage discussion, build capacity, gain consensus, align initiatives and foster respect."

"Furthermore, with the election upon us, now is the time for New Zealanders to develop a national strategy, not because we have to, but because we want what it can deliver."
