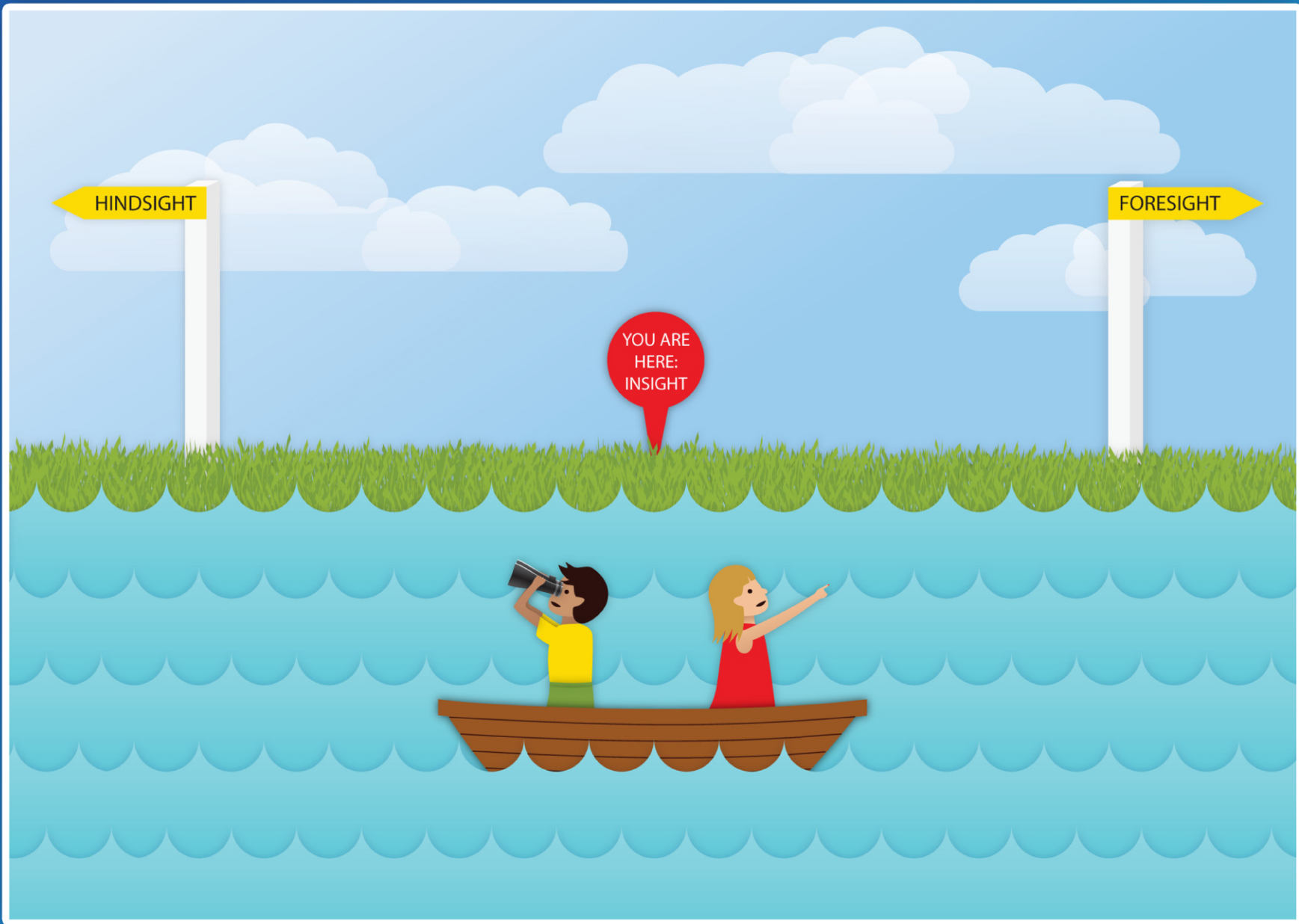

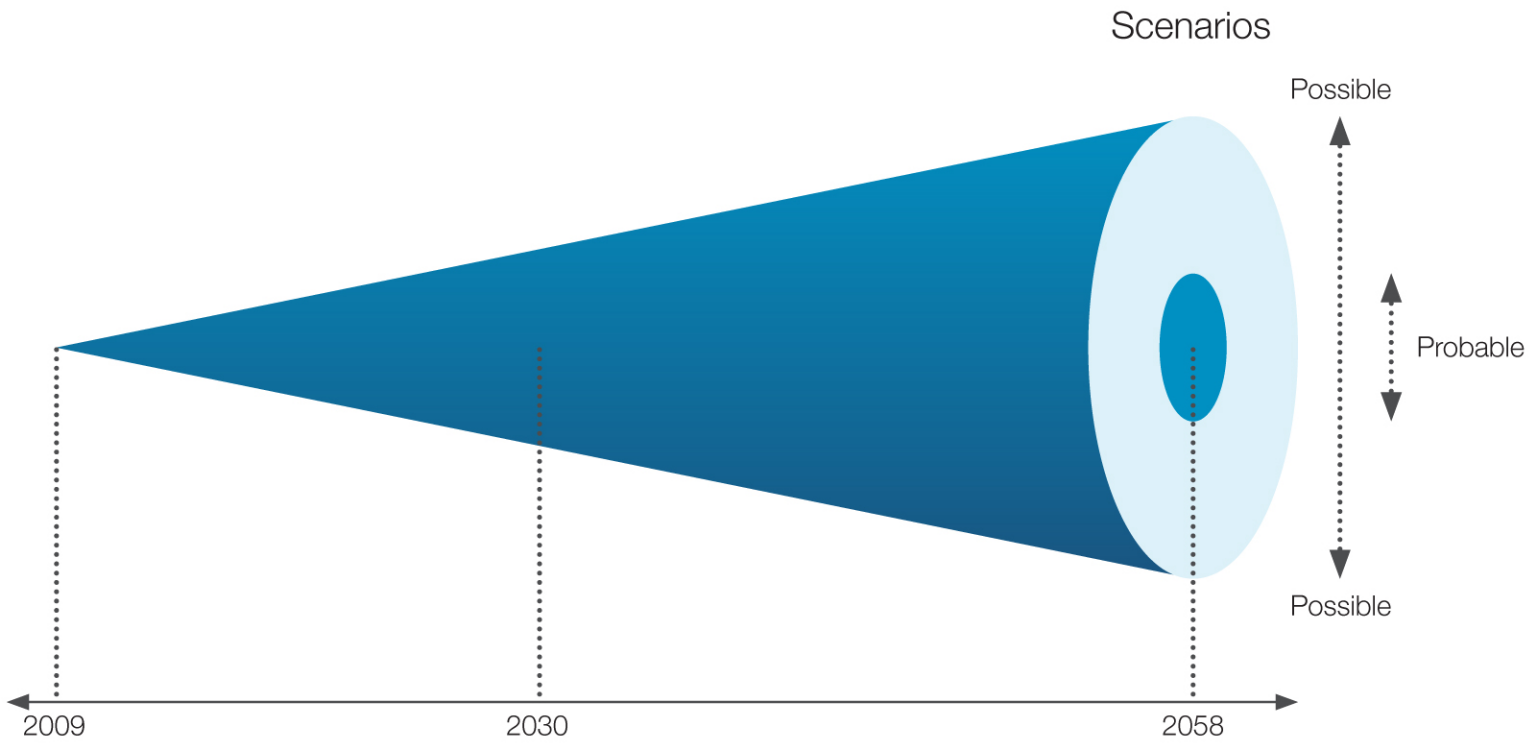

Hindsight: 4.5 billion years ago

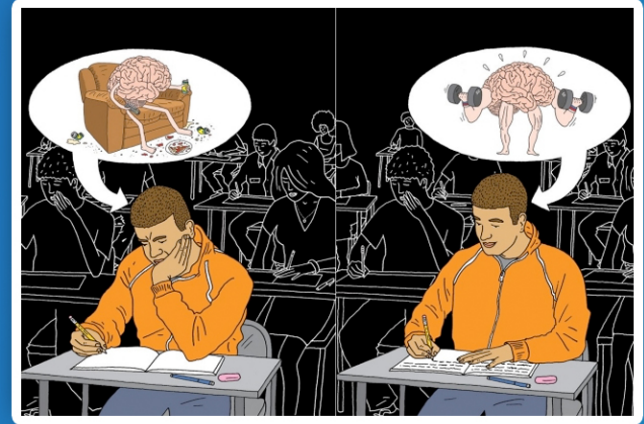

Can You Build a Better Brain?

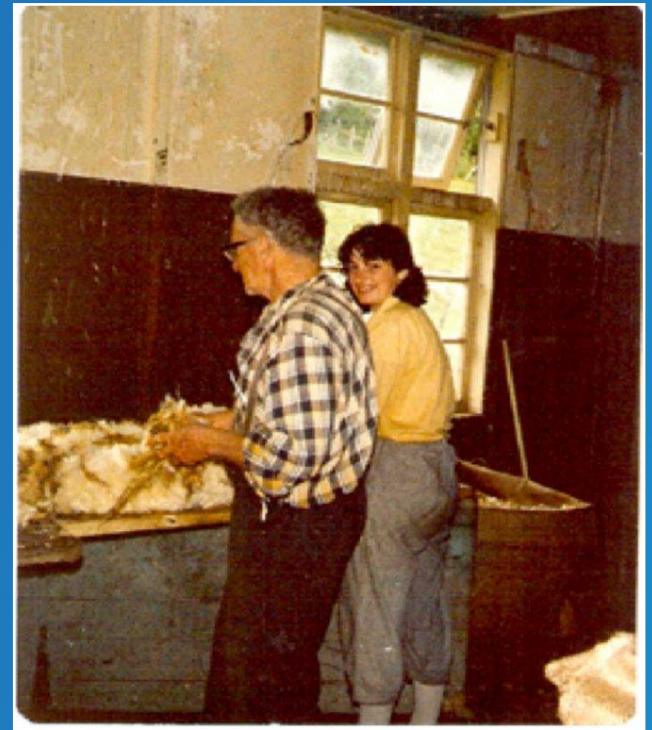
Blueberries and crossword puzzles aren't going to do it. But as neuroscientists discover the mechanisms of intelligence, they are identifying what really works.
