

Futures Studies – The Theory

Three P's


 Probable future - Forecasting and sometimes prediction (Status Quo)
 Possible futures - Scenarios, risks (Explorative)
 Preferred futures - Strategies for change, propelled by innovation & leadership (Visionary)

Four Steps


Define - parameters, trends, drivers, assumptions
Explore - uncertainties and rank
Build - scenario worlds, write stories, test
Use - consider implications, review, communicate

The Three Sights



Values – what we believe is important?


Vision – what we want the future to be?




Strategy Map for Brazil








